AN ORDINANCE NO 16-FIN-16 (Unanimous Pass)
(Second Reading) To amend the General Fund Budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016 and ending June 30, 2017, to appropriate funds in the aggregate amount of \$874,566, which consists of a re-appropriation of \$527,958 in encumbered FY 2016 funds, as required under the Government Accounting Standards Board (GASB) for budgetary reporting purposes; \$16,816 in Police Forfeited Assets to purchase equipment and supplies for an SRO position; \$3,251 from a Byrne Justice Grant to purchase police vehicle graphics and a computer; \$2,550 in donations for the Youth Christmas Shopping Program (\$1,550) and the Police Awards Program (\$1,000); \$12,600 in grants from the VA Department of Emergency Medical Services to purchase video conference equipment for the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) (\$11,200) and to purchase supplies and equipment to establish an alternate EOC in Fire Station 2 (\$1,400); and

To amend the Capital Projects Fund Budget in the aggregate amount of \$3,11,391 to appropriate \$249,113 from the VA Department of Emergency Medical Services Grant and

\$62,278 from Fund Balance – Apparatus, to purchase an Emergency Medical Unit and Stretcher/Loader System.
