## Election Day Arrest

On November 8, 2016, at approximately 12:47 p.m., a citizen, who was waving a campaign sign on E. Ellerslie Avenue at the I-95 overpass, was approached by a subject inquiring about a handgun that the victim was wearing on his side. During the conversation, the suspect forcibly took the victim's handgun and ran towards Dunlop Village Shopping Center. Within minutes of receiving the call, Colonial Heights Police officers had the suspect in custody and recovered the handgun. The suspect has been charged with strong-armed robbery, larceny of a firearm, grand larceny with intent to sell, and resisting arrest. The suspect is currently being held at the Riverside Regional Jail with no bond.
