## Bank Robbery Suspect Sought

On April 8, 2017 at approximately 11:04 a.m., an unidentified suspect entered Bank of America, located in the 1900 block of the Boulevard, and presented the teller with a note demanding money. The suspect did not display a weapon. After obtaining cash, the suspect fled and was last seen getting into an older model maroon vehicle, possibly a Mercury or a Ford, that was parked in the parking lot.

The suspect is described as a black male, wearing a black coat, dark shirt, and possibly blue jeans. He is believed to be in his middle 20s to middle 30s and is approximately 5'8" to 5'10" tall and 170-190 lbs. He has a light beard with a full mustache and an earring in his left ear.
