Colonial Heights Police arrest two individuals for narcotics and weapons charges

On November 6, 2017, officers with the Colonial Heights Police Department were on foot patrol in the Colonial Apartments, located in the area of Beechwood Avenue and Maple Grove Avenue. Officers were alerted to the odor of narcotics coming from an apartment and as a result made contact with two occupants.

Eddie Taylor Jr., 41 of Colonial Heights, was arrested and charged with Possession of a firearm with a schedule 1 or 2 controlled substance, Possession of a firearm by a convicted felon, Possession with the intent to distribute a schedule 1 or 2 controlled substance, Possession with intent to distribute marijuana, Distribution of narcotics within 1000 feet of a school and Maintaining a common nuisance.

Mr. Taylor was ordered held without bond at Riverside Regional Jail. His next court appearance will be on January 3, 2018 at the Colonial Heights General District Court.

Jamel Lawrence McDuffie, 38 of Colonial Heights, was charged with Possession of marijuana and released at the scene.
