## Colonial Heights Police Investigate Domestic Related Shooting

On Sunday, March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at approximately 7:18 p.m., Colonial Heights Police responded to a residential address in the 3200 block of Glenview Avenue for a report of a person with a gunshot wound. Officers found an adult female inside the residence who had been shot. The victim was transported to VCU Medical Center. The suspect, who is the victim's husband, was identified as Mark Alan Nance, 62 years of age, a resident of Colonial Heights. Nance, who had fled the scene on foot prior to the arrival of law enforcement, was located inside of a garage behind the residence.

Officers from Colonial Heights, with the assistance of specially trained officers from Chesterfield County Police Department communicated with Nance for several hours in an attempt to peacefully resolve the situation. Shortly after 1:00 a.m., Nance was transported to VCU Medical Center with a self-inflicted gunshot wound.

A Warrant for Felony Malicious Wounding has been secured.

There is no photograph available at this time. This remains an active investigation and there is no further information to release at this time.
