Notice of Water Service Interruption

This Friday night, water service to customers will be temporarily interrupted in the service area bounded by Ellerslie Avenue to the south, Swift Creek to the north, I-95 to the west and the Appomattox River to the east. The repair location will be near the intersection of Stratford Drive and Conduit Road.

The temporary water outage is scheduled to begin at 10:00 PM, Friday, November 4 and is anticipated to last six hours with water service fully restored by 4:00 AM, Saturday, November 5.

During the service interruption city utility crews will be replacing a defective water valve near the intersection of Conduit Road and Stratford Road.

After service has been restored and before consuming water, customers should flush their household water systems. Flushing can be accomplished by opening some or all water faucets for a few minutes. This will allow discolored water to clear and will release any air trapped in the system.

The City of Colonial Heights regrets the inconvenience this service interruption may cause and appreciates our customers' patience and understanding.
