 - Sections 2.2-3711.A.3 and 2.2-3711.A.7 – to discuss or consider the disposition of publicly held real property – specifically, the City-owned real estate off Charles Dimmock Parkway and the site of the current Colonial Heights Courthouse on Temple Avenue - where discussion in an open meeting would adversely affect the bargaining position or negotiating strategy of the public body; and to consult with legal counsel employed by a public body regarding a specific legal matter requiring the provision of legal advice by such counsel – namely, the interpretation of the Memorandum of Understanding Sharing Local Revenue between the City of Colonial Heights and the School Board and possible amendments thereto.
 - B. Holding a closed meeting pursuant to the Code of Virginia in accordance with the following provision:**
 - Section 2.2-3711.A.1 – to discuss and consider appointments to the Historical Commission, Economic Development Authority, Personnel Board, Senior Citizens Advisory Board, and Youth Services Commission.
