    - d. Section 2.2-3711.A.7 – for consultation with legal counsel employed by a public body regarding a specific legal matter – i.e., a possible agreement with a business – requiring the provision of legal advice by such counsel; and**
    - e. Section 2.2-3711.A.3 – to discuss and consider the acquisition of easements for the Appomattox River Trail System for a public purpose where discussion in an open meeting would adversely affect the bargaining position or negotiating strategy of the public body.**
