## **ELEVATED EFFORTS FOR SPECIAL COLLECTION OF IRENE STORM DEBRIS**

The Department of Public Works previously announced the schedule for free collection services to city residents of storm-related debris remaining from Hurricane Irene on September 8.

This collection service began on Friday September 23 in the Sherwood Hills neighborhood (zone 1). Crews are performing an initial collection of storm-related debris within all zones to boost efforts and to more rapidly and efficiently collect debris within the City. Collection in some zones has and will occur earlier than indicated on the attached Schedule of Collection map. Crews are regularly collecting debris from within each individual zone until one passage through all zones has been completed. Once this initial collection from all zones has been completed, crews will perform a 2nd passage and final collection on the end date indicated for each zone to collect all debris that was not set out during the initial collection. Further information for debris disposal after these end dates for collection will be provided at a future date.

Residents are urged to move all storm-related yard debris to a location next to the curb or pavement (yard side) prior to the day before the end of collection in their area as indicated on the Schedule of Collection. Please place debris away from any obstructions such as parked cars or fire hydrants, etc., which will prevent access to and collection of the debris. Please do not place debris in the street or in any ditch. Debris should not obstruct traffic or drainage flow.


Storm-related household waste is not included in this free special service. City residents may place household waste and small quantities of yard debris into trash receptacles and bags for normal pickup on Wednesdays of each week.

Residents may also dispose of unbagged yard debris free of charge at the City's Recycling Center, located at 2701 Conduit Road. The Recycling Center hours are Friday and Saturday, 8 AM to 12 PM and 1 PM to 5 PM.
