WRIT OF ELECTION

This matter came to be heard upon the Petition for Writ of Election filed by the City Council of the City of Colonial Heights, Virginia, pursuant to Subsection A of Virginia Code § 24.2-226, requesting this Court to issue a writ of election to fill a vacancy on the City Council.

It appearing to the Court that it is proper to do so, it is hereby ORDERED that a special election shall be held on November 8, 2022, concurrently with a general election on that date, to fill the vacancy on the Colonial Heights City Council created by the resignation of Michael A. Cherry, whose term expires on December 31, 2024.

It is further ORDERED that the Colonial Heights General Registrar and the Virginia State Board of Elections take those actions necessary to modify the ballots so that the voters of the City of Colonial Heights shall be permitted to vote on November 8, 2022, for a candidate for City Council to fill the unexpired term of Michael A. Cherry.

The Clerk of this Court is hereby directed to send certified copies of this Order to the Colonial Heights General Registrar, the Virginia State Board of Elections, and the Colonial Heights City Attorney.
